Is being a Jew mainly about religion, or is it about ethnicity? **Rabbi Ethan Tucker**, *President and Rosh Yeshiva at the Hadar Institute* explores this age-old question by tracing how Jewish identity has been understood across history. Beginning with the era of Alexander the Great—when religion and ethnicity first started to come apart—he shows how this shift sparked a centuries-long debate within the Jewish people. From the Torah through medieval thinkers and beyond, Rabbi Tucker offers a sweeping yet accessible look at how Jews have wrestled with whether Judaism is primarily a faith, a people, or both. **INVITE YOUR FRIENDS!** Open to the community.
