**\$108,000**

Helps released soldiers overcome combat-related trauma. Training for 30 new facilitators to help expand scope of activities and meet increased demand for psychological support.

Shelter, food and childcare for evacuees staying in Carmei Gat

### **Chamah**

**\$30,000**

Meals, food boxes and food coupons for 430 elderly, transportation for volunteers

## Israel Emergency Fund Allocations

### Haifa Rape Crisis Center

**\$50,000**

Training and mentorship for professional teams and for displaced and host communities. To help/detect abuse and make help accessible. Educational workshops and activities

### Hashomer Hachadash

**\$10,000**

Connects volunteers with farmers to assist with citrus harvest. Recruit volunteers, provide them with transportation, accomodation, food and clothing.

### Healing Spaces

**\$36,000**

Tranquil healing center in Rishpon for those with active trauma providing various forms of therapy like music therapy, sound therapy, etc.

### Israel Trauma Coalition

**\$50,000**

Emotional first aid workshops for teams including firefighters, ZAKA (search and rescue) and local emergency teams nationwide

Animal therapy for children dealing with trauma

**\$25,000**

### Israel Women's Network

**\$15,000**

Women's Rights Response Center to assist women dealing with gender-based violence - through immediate relief and long-term systemic change

Assistance for women to exercise their rights on war-related issues (unemployment, national insurance, compensation, etc.). Provide assistance in four languages; advocacy in the Knesset

Employment support services for eight evacuated kibbutzim/towns includes counseling, career advice, job training, childcare. Mobile Employment Centers/community support. Serve 50-100 clients in each community

Connect elderly at risk of social isolation to their peers and to community activities

**\$20,000**

### **Jerusalem Open House**

**\$15,000**

Emergency support for LGBTQ+ soldiers-individual and group therapy- returning from combat in Gaza and the North

### **Jewish Agency for Israel**

**\$50,000**

Psychological treatment, counseling, and support for lone soldiers suffering trauma

Fund for Victims of Terror: Immediate and long-term rehabilitation grants for terror survivors/families, camps and support for children, support for border communities, therapeutic group interventions
