



## **Request for Proposals – Miami-Yerucham Partnership**

The Miami-Yerucham Partnership Committee at the Greater Miami Jewish Federation is requesting proposals for its 2020-2021 grant process. The committee is looking for projects that bolster the strategic Partnership goals. Grant award amounts will vary and will align with the goals, vision and mission statement of the Partnership. Proposals that involve people-to-people elements are a priority, as well as joint proposals created by organizations and groups in Miami and Yerucham.

Partnership Goals:

- 1. People-to-people and organization-to-organization opportunities in both communities
- 2. Developing and enhancing specific target audiences youth, young adults and young families for people-topeople opportunities and engagement in the Partnership
- 3. Entrepreneurship as a vehicle towards resource development and demographic growth in Yerucham
- 4. Educational programs highlighting the Partnership while using cutting edge technology
- 5. Joint learning as a vehicle to strengthen Jewish identity and Peoplehood in the context of the Partnership
- 6. Communication as a vehicle to increase awareness, support and involvement in the Partnership
