Protecting Women Against Violence

ASLI WHITE RIBBON	\$20,000
General Support: Aims to engage men and boys in efforts to eliminate violence toward women	
ASSOCIATION OF RAPE CRISIS CENTERS: CHANGING LAWS, CHANGING LIVES	\$25,000
General Support: Improve services offered to victims of sexual assault and promote social change.	
MASLAN: THE NEGEV'S SEXUAL ASSAULT AND DOMESTIC VIOLENCE SUPPORT CENTER	\$25,000
Support for victims of sexual and physical violence, including individual assistance and therapy, group sessions, therapeutic retreats, holistic support, and social workers' training and enrichment.	
MICHAL SELA FOUNDATION	\$20,000
General Support: To combat domestic violence through innovation and technological solutions focusing on education, campaigns and policy making.	
WOMEN'S SPIRIT: BREAKING THE BIND – FINANCIAL INDEPENDENCE FOR WOMEN SURVIVORS OF VIOLENCE	\$21,500

Economic Empowerment

ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT FOR WOMEN: A BUSINESS OF ONE'S OWN	\$15,000
Assist low-income, marginalized women to reach economic independence through self-employment. Meetings with empowerment and business facilitators, technical assistance and mentoring for women, and personal consulting.	
ITWORKS: MOTHERS FROM CRISIS TO OPPORTUNITY	\$20,000
Vocational technological training and job placement assistance in the hi-tech industry for single mothers, with a special focus on evacuees and those impacted by the war.	
LA'OFEK: ACHOTENU/NACHSHONIM ACADEMIC NURSES TRAINING PROGRAM	\$20,000
Training program for Ethiopian-Israelis studying nursing, paramedics and occupational therapy to help them complete academic studies and find employment, in partnership with Hebrew University, Hadassah Hospital.	
THE JERUSALEM COLLEGE OF TECHNOLOGY SCHREIBER LEVTECH ENTREPRENEURSHIP CENTER	\$27,600
Provides Orthodox students with training in creative thinking and skills necessary to become entrepreneurs as innovators through participation in a pre-accelerator program, hackathons, industry-led workshops, and student-led clubs.	
YOZMOT ATID: FINANCIAL EMPOWERMENT FOR HAREDI WOMEN	\$14,100
Entrepreneurship program to develop, launch and run viable businesses, includes business training, mentoring, networking and micro-loans.

Social Empowerment

ADVA: Core GENDER PROGRAM **\$16,600**

Research, monitor and advocacy of policy on issues that are critical for women in Israel.

ATID BAMIDBAR: ECONOMIC & SOCIAL EMPOWERMENT OF NEGEV BEDOUIN WOMEN **\$ 19,400**

Help Negev Bedouin women learn about and exercise their civil rights.

ISRAEL RELIGIOUS ACTION CENTER **\$17,300**

General Support: Legal and public advocacy in combatting gender segregation via court cases and public awareness campaigns.

RACKMAN CENTER AT BAR ILAN UNIVERSITY: PROTECTING WOMEN’S EQUALITY IN ISRAEL **\$19,400**

Policy and legal advocacy, education and outreach to advance the status of women, as well as assistance to individual women with difficult family law cases.

FORUM DVORAH **\$23,500**

Personal empowerment volunteer-year program for 54 young Druze women volunteering in 14 Druze communities who will serve as mentors and tutors of 3,500 children and teens that participate in youth activities.
