Grant award amounts will vary and will align with the goals, vision and mission statement of the Partnership. Proposals that involve people-to-people elements are a priority, as well as joint proposals put together by groups in Miami and Yerucham.

Partnership Goals:

2. Developing specific target audiences – youth, young adults and young families for people-to-people opportunities and engagement in the Partnership
3. Entrepreneurship as a vehicle towards resource development and demographic growth in Yerucham
